The Village of St. Jacobs

Established in 1852, the Village of St. Jacobs, located just outside of Waterloo, Ontario, has a rich Mennonite heritage that's just waiting to be rediscovered. A 10 minute drive at most, check the village website for a directory of specialty shops and other heritage features.



Martin's Apple Farm

The Martin family has farmed these Ontario lands since 1820. From a modest start in the 1070's the farm now harvests from over 2 million trees. The Martin farm market is open on Fridays 9:00 - 6:00 and Saturday 8:00-4:00 (brochure included)

Just at the north end of the Village of St. Jacob's sits PICARD'S.
